



**COGNITIVE DOMAIN:** Knowledge; what graduates will know.

*Knowledge and Comprehension*

- ◆ Diagnose damage and report damage repair formats
- ◆ Exhibit the ability to work safely alone and around others
- ◆ Demonstrate proper use of filler on a complete repair
- ◆ Demonstrate proper detail work

*Application*

- ◆ Research and obtain a cost estimate for work details
- ◆ Demonstrate the use of safety techniques
- ◆ Communicate with customer or owner to determine repairs
- ◆ Perform repairs to industry-standard and customer approval

*Analysis, Synthesis & Evaluation*

- ◆ Assess customer concerns to determine required repair areas
- ◆ Evaluate the most efficient way to repair damage for a reasonable profit

**AFFECTIVE DOMAIN:** Attitude; growth in feelings or emotional areas

- ◆ Ability to be on time
- ◆ Ability to work under time limits
- ◆ Ability to make decisions without constant supervision
- ◆ Ability to control stress levels
- ◆ Self-motivated
- ◆ Inquisitive Nature

**PSYCHOMOTOR DOMAIN:** Skills; manual or physical

- ◆ Be able to use general hand tools & equipment
- ◆ Be able to stand on a concrete floor while sanding for at least 30 minutes
